Floristic Quality Assessment

Floristic Quality: How and Why did FQA originate? What does it have to do with plant communities? What does it have to do with rare or endangered species. What is Floristic Quality? What is species conservatism; does it vary from region to region, state to state? What is FQA used for? How has FQA been misunderstood and misused.
